Court support:

A support group for female-identified sexual violence survivors navigating the court system.

Who:

- Women who have experienced sexual violence, or assault and are currently, have been, or will be involved in a court case.
- All women who self identify as women/femme (cisgender, trans*, gender queer, non binary, and other)
- Age 18+

What:

Confidential female-identified support group. Led by peers, supported by mental health professionals.

When:

Every 2nd Monday of the Month: April 13, May 11, June 8, July 13, August 10. Arrive at 6:20pm, group will be held from 6:30pm - 8:30pm.

To hear women's stories and have the opportunity to share your own. Give and receive support from women who have shared experiences of standing up to sexual violence in the court system.

Format:

The group will use a circle process. One member will begin the circle by sharing her story and thoughts; other members will be able to respond if they choose. After everyone has responded, the group will then move to the next person who wants to share.
